# **About YRSC**



Young Researchers in Sciences Conference (YRSC) is an International cluster conference that brings an innovative touch in contrast to the traditional science gatherings. Students for Nature Organization (OSpN) and Institute for Science and Innovation in Society (ISIS), in collaboration with our host, the Faculty of Biology and Geology, Babeş-Bolyai University are proud to present a step forward for our 4<sup>th</sup> edition of Young Researchers in Bio-Sciences international symposium, by adding two branches: Young Researchers in Chemical-Sciences and Young Researchers in Physics-Sciences, and bringing them all under one main event: Young Researchers in Sciences Conference. This event will take place between 14<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> of August, in Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

Spanning over the three most researched natural sciences, biology, chemistry and physics, this Conference aims to spark an interest in interdisciplinarity, and help bachelor's, master's and PhD students gain knowledge and experience, all the while forming partnerships, and why not, friendships. 
Participants will be hosted 2 or 3 in rooms.
